Omkring 1850 bodde närmare 60 personer i den här gården. En utfattig före detta krögare med familj, en utfattig trossmakare Widmark med familj, däribland dottern Johanna som var liten och klen. Här bodde även änkan Schultz och en avskedad soldat Hagman, båda två utfattiga.

The Shoemaker's House

Around 1850, almost 60 people lived in the property. One of them was an impoverished former innkeeper and his family, as well as destitute Hawser-maker Widmark with family. Widmarks daughter Johanna was rather frail and small in stature. Widow Schultz and dismissed Soldier Hagman also lived here, both destitute.
